PURPOSE

The Biblical Studies Certificate is recommended for those students who are considering further biblical or theological education, either at PLBC or at a seminary. The Biblical Studies Certificate comprises the first year of studies of the four-year Bachelor of Arts programs, making transferal into one of PLBC’s two- or four-year programs simple should the student wish to continue their studies. The Diploma and BA programs are designed for those who are planning to go on to seminary studies. It places special emphasis on the study and interpretation of the Bible while also providing a broad foundation for pastoral ministry.
