Children and Family Ministry



The BA in Children's & Family Ministry is a program for those who feel called to be an advocate for children and their unique spiritual development within the church community and beyond. Students have the opportunity to live out what they learn in the classroom as they enter into practicums that equip them for church leadership in children's and family ministries.

As students study the Bible, theology, and psychology, as well as practice servant-hearted leadership, they develop a solid foundation for a life in ministry to children. Graduates from this program will go on to work as pastors in various capacities (such as children & family ministries pastor), in parachurch organizations, and in social work settings. Others will continue with graduate studies or pursue additional education as teachers.

This program is designed for those who are preparing specifically for Children's & Family Ministry. The core requirements provide a broad foundation of personal and pastoral development in understanding children and how best to nurture their spirituality through safe and meaningful ministry.

In addition to meeting the learning goals and objectives required for all degree programs, the Biblical Studies and Children's & Family Ministry Major will enable graduates to:

- Articulate a biblically and theologically infused personal philosophy of Children's Ministry.
- Incorporate childhood psycho-social-spiritual developmental theories into ministering to children.
- Understand how historical and cultural perspectives, both in and outside of churches, influenced ministering to children.
- Incorporate a theological grounding in Creation, Christ, and Salvation as it pertains to children and their spiritual identity.
- Become an advocate in the church and wider community for the health and wellbeing of children and their families.
- Exercise competencies in children's ministry, including teaching, nurturing spiritual formation, recruiting volunteers, and building teams.
- Plan programs and activities that promote children's involvement in the church that are safe and meaningful.
