Connect Church is seeking a creative and dynamic leader to become a part of the team loving God and loving others in Cranbrook, BC, Canada. Cranbrook is the hub of the East Kootenay's and is beautifully situated in the valley between the Rocky and Purcell Mountain ranges. Connect's mission is simple: introduce Jesus, learn our identity and make a difference.

In its first 17 years, Connect has had a heart to be a church that reaches out to those who do not yet know Jesus and has had over 600 new believers baptized. We have a desire to lead people to God in a way that is heartfelt, engaging and culturally relevant.

This individual must have a strong faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour of his/her life and maintain a loving, Christ-centered focus, attitude, and standard of personal conduct both within and outside the church. Their fun and engaging attitude should be evident in how they interact with others. This individual is expected to attend and direct the Sunday worship and midweek special services throughout the year, and may work irregular days or hours including weekdays, nights, and holidays.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities (2/3s of position)

- * With oversight of the Senior Leader, plan music for the Sunday worship service on a weekly basis. Music should be selected with the church's theme for the week in mind, pushing the context for expression and innovation and keeping both seasoned believers and someone with little to no church experience, in mind.
- * Lead the Music team for Sunday mornings. Leading vocally regularly.
- * Conduct Worship Team rehearsal weekly as well as lead devotionals and development exercises.
- * Organize a monthly schedule for the band, working with the various members availabilities and giftings.
- * Arrange music as needed for the instrumentation on the worship team for any given week.
- * Recruit and train other musicians to join the group, and be a part of the Worship Team rotations ie. growing the next generation of musicians.
- * Maintain a music library (both lyrics and chord charts) of songs sung through Planning Center and search for appropriate new music to add to the repertoire.
- * Lead creative planning and oversee production teams (lighting, sound, setup and media)

Requirements

Required knowledge, skills, and abilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- * leadership skills and experience
- * skilled as a worship team director, with a familiarity and appreciation for all types of music
- * proficient in the guitar or other musical instrument, as well as the capability of being a lead vocalist
- * detail oriented and capable of coordinating high quality worship services
- * able to create an atmosphere through music that is consistent with the spiritual theme for any given week and enhances the congregation's worship experience
- * flexible and capable of working effectively both independently and as part of a team with members of the staff, worship team, congregation, and the general public. Exhibits a high level of interpersonal and communication skills

Other Assets For Hire (1/3 of position)

- * graphic design experience and skills working with photoshop, illustrator and/ or other design software.
- * experience working in website development and design
- * experience working in events with production teams (sound, lighting, video and media)
- * ability to shoot, edit and produce video to enhance the worship environments.
- * experience in working with and editing live video
