Job description:

Church planting support workers are responsible for assisting the Abbotsford Baptist Church Replant Team (Seedling Church Planting Team) as we make the transition from Abbotsford Baptist to the new BCBC church plant Seedling Church, officially launching Sept. 24, 2023. The church planting support worker will assist in planning, leading and implementing various summer community outreach programs run out of the church facilities and in the community. Under the direction of the Replant Team they will assist in the planning and hosting of neighbourhood barbecues and other outreach events. They will assist in planning and hosting community meals, particularly geared to persons and families experiencing food insecurity in Abbotsford. They will be helping to run pop-up recreational outdoor day camps for children in various neighbourhood green spaces; a kids summer drama camp; and a kids summer coding camp.

The church planting support workers will help develop and implement community spaces on the Abbotsford Baptist Church property. They will also help develop and maintain social media presence for Seedling Church and the various outreach initiatives, and will help with the preparation and maintenance of the facilities to be used for these events. The Ministry Support Workers will be asked to help research the needs and demographics surrounding the church, and to give input and initiative into what types of programs might best benefit the community.

Church planting support workers will help with the day to day activities and worship services of the church, preparation for which will include prayer and Bible study. Along with the Ministry Team, they will help to ensure that all community outreach initiatives are safe, positive, welcoming, and inclusive experiences for all involved.

The work schedule for this position is semi-flexible, and will include some evening and weekend hours, including Sundays, for a weekly total of 30hrs.

An interest in church planting and community outreach, and an ability to work with people of all ages and backgrounds (including children) are required. The Seedling Church Planting Team believes that it takes a wide variety of personalities, skills and spiritual gifts to operate as a flourishing body, so there will be an atmosphere of encouraging each Church Planting Support Worker to identify, develop and use their unique calling as they serve with Seedling Church.
